


Experience the Gullah Geechee Culture of the South Carolina Coast: Hilton Head and Daufuskie Island

OPTIONAL HALF DAY: If it's February, participate in the annual Native Islander Gullah Celebration, or during Fall weekends any number of waterfront festivals are presented. Visit the Heritage Museum and do some research on your family roots.



HALF DAY: Tour historic Daufuskie Island. Travel back in time along the unspoiled coast visiting the First Union African Baptist Church, the Mary Fields School and galleries featuring local folk art.
